

OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND
AMENDING R-53-84 TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF THE
CITY OF BOWIE'S CABLE TELEVISION ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND
RENAMING IT THE BOWIE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to receive advice from persons in the community having expertise in matters related to the use and operation of cable television system in the City; and

WHEREAS, by R-53-84, the City Council created a Cable Television Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it appropriate to amend R-53-84 to expand the scope of the Cable Television Advisory Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bowie, Maryland that R-53-84 be amended as follows:

Section 1: Purpose and Function

a) The Committee is hereby formed to serve as a forum for citizen input concerning information and technology matters;

b) To assure non-discrimination in public use of information and technology service;

c) To monitor legislative and technological trends in information and technology and advise the City Council thereon;

d) To interface with other area information and technology committees;

e) To assist and advise the City Council in reviewing local regulations and procedures deemed necessary to provide effective and efficient use of technology services for the citizens.


Section 2: Membership

The Committee shall consist of five (5) members.

Section 3: Rules and Regulations

The Committee shall be governed by the Rules and Regulations for City Committees as adopted and amended by the Council.
