

5. Payments are non-refundable unless replacements can be found from the waiting list. Certain exceptions will be handled per Management.
 6. Participants must furnish their own transportation to and from the Center. Park as far away as possible so others attending the Center that day will have access to reasonable parking. Arrive 15-30 minutes prior to departure time.
 7. Passengers will sit in the same bus seats both to and from the schedule destinations.
 8. No smoking or alcoholic beverages on buses.
 9. **Buses will not wait for anyone.** Participants must adhere to scheduled arrival and departure times and are responsible for their own transportation if they miss the bus. Should you become separated from the group use the information on your ID tag to call the Trip Leader or Center.
 10. ***Some trips require extensive walking and independence. Be mindful of your limitations when signing up for a trip.**
The Center cannot guarantee the availability of wheelchairs or seating at all destinations. Those who have difficulty with mobility, orientation/memory or other health issues should check with Center Management before registering.
 11. All trip participants will be issued Center ID tags. These ID tags will identify them as members of the group. In addition, every person should carry a photo ID along with an index card that includes name, address, emergency contact and list of current medications .
- *In case of an emergency the Trip Leader should be contacted. If that is not possible the member should call the Senior Center. If the member requires medical care and is transported to an emergency facility, the Trip Leader will be in communication with the Senior Center . The member's family or emergency contact will be notified and will assume responsibility for the member.
