Terms and Conditions

1. Registration fee must be paid in full at time of registration. The registration fee is based on two semesters (Fall- August 25, 2011-December 7, 2011; Spring – January 26 –June 2, 2012).. Registration is \$100 for Bowie residents and \$110 for non-Bowie residents* total for both semesters. Payment options are considered on an individual need basis.
2. Late registration will not be prorated for missed classes. There will be a \$5 administration fee for late registrations. There will be NO MAKE UP CLASSES.
3. Once the sessions begin August 25, 2011, there will be no refunds unless the student is requested to leave the chorus. Refunds before August 25 will require a written note from the parents requesting the refund. \$25 of the fee will be retained and not refunded.
4. There is a \$25 fee for checks returned by the bank for any reason.
5. The City of Bowie reserves the right to change or cancel classes. In the event that an entire semester is cancelled all fees will be refunded.
6. As a condition of enrollment, the parent/guardian of the participant agrees to indemnify, release and hold harmless the City of Bowie for any injury the student, parent, siblings or guests might receive on the premises, and further agree that this shall be a complete bar to any claim for personal injury.
7. There will be a costume fee required of all new chorus members. The charge is a one-time, not semester charge, for a polo shirt and a dress uniform for concerts. The costume fee is \$100, and is due at the time of registration, unless other arrangements are approved by the Music Director.
8. In the Fall 2011-Spring 2012 season we will be organizing a fund raiser and all chorus members will participate in the fund raiser that will raise monies for musical instruments, costuming, bus fees for events, and other chorus needs.
9. Parent help will be required in order to have a successful program. Areas where parents will assist include fund raising, publicity, and concert programs. Committees will be formed at the parent meeting. Signs up and more information on this will be provided at the parent meeting which will be held Thursday, September 8, at 5 p.m.
10. Rehearsals start Thursday, August 25, 2011, at 5 p.m. for the Youth Chorus. Interested high school students are invited to audition at the Kenhill Center on Thursday, September 1, or Thursday, September 8, at 7:30 p.m.

It is agreed that the City of Bowie shall have the privilege, with or without cause, to cancel and annul this agreement at any time upon written notice by registered mail, or personal delivery of notice to the party affected.

This agreement is entire and not divisible and represents the entire agreement between the parties. The student or parent/guardian assumes responsibility for the full amount of the tuition set forth herein.
