

Tanglewood Park - (Off of Zug Road) is a 128 acre passive park with trails for hiking.

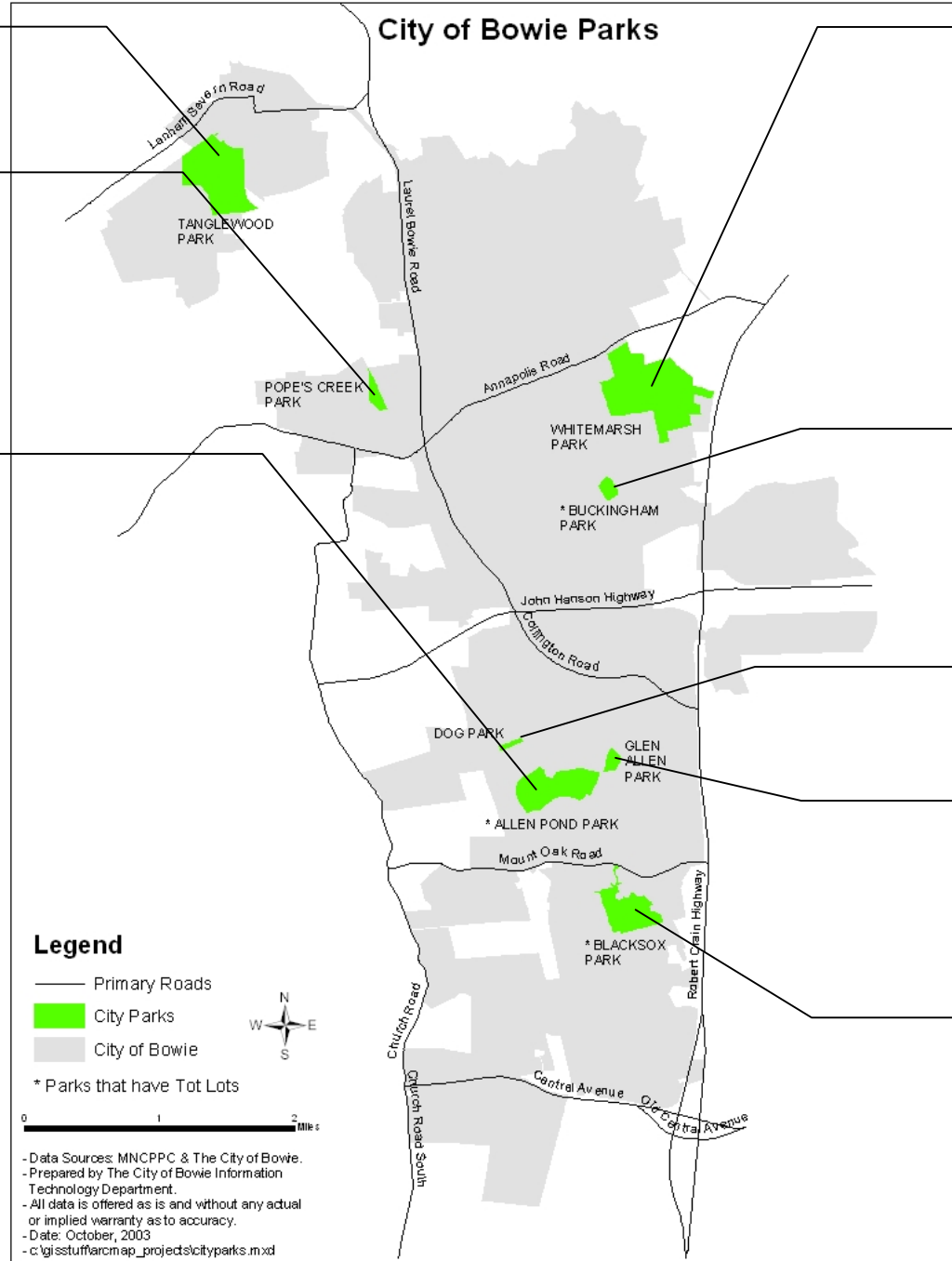
Popes Creek Park - 13 acre park, located off of Geoffrey Road in the Highbridge Park development, contains an adult and tot soccer field, softball field and picnic areas.

Allen Pond Park - (3330 Northview Drive) is an 85-acre area that also includes the Bowie Ice Arena and Opportunity Park.

Two pavilion picnic areas and 5 group picnic areas are available for rental. Family picnic tables are also available on a first come-first served basis for groups of than 25 people or less.

Paddleboat, canoe and rowboat rentals are available. Private watercraft permits may be obtained.

6 ballfields (3 soccer fields, 2 softball fields, and one combination soccer/softball field) are lit.



Whitmarsh Park - (16200 White Marsh Park Drive) located on Route 3 South between 50 and 450, is a 182-acre multi-use park which includes the Bowie Playhouse, four lighted ballfields, picnic areas and pavilions, a campfire circle, hiking and biking trails and a playground. The picnic pavilion, campfire circle, ballfields and playhouse are available for reservations at City Hall.

Buckingham Park - (2800 Barberry Lane) is a 10 acre community park It has three youth baseball fields, a soccer field, walking/biking trails and basketball court. The park also has two playgrounds and picnic areas.

Bowie Dog Park - (3600 Northview Drive) is a one acre park with parking and 2 fenced-in areas.

Glen Allen Park - (15600 Atlantis Drive) is a 9 acre park with 2 tennis courts, a softball field, soccer field and youth soccer field. Children's play area and family picnic pavilion are available.

Blacksox Park - (2200 Mitchellville Road) is a 64 acre park primarily designed for baseball and softball. It also has hiker/biker trails and a playground on the north side of the park at the Mt. Oak Road entrance. There is also a rentable concession stand. Contact the City of Bowie at 301-809-3076.
