Consultant to Present Whitemarsh Park Master Plan Concept

On December 7th Lardner/Klein Landscape Architects PC will present the master plan concept being considered by the City for the enhancement of Whitemarsh Park. The presentation will provide the public with a park master plan that will address the City's need to improve pedestrian and vehicular traffic within Whitemarsh Park, expand and improve available parking, add public restroom and concession facilities, and improve the athletic field configurations to better accommodate the existing football and lacrosse programs.

The master plan will provide a visual and descriptive explanation of the master plan concept and how it was developed. The concept will identify improved pedestrian and vehicular traffic within the park, expansion of parking areas, installation of a modern restroom & concession facility and an updated playground, the installation of a second lacrosse/football game field and two additional multi-use practice fields that will accommodate the lacrosse/football programs as they exist today. Public input is crucial to ensure the master plan appropriately serves residents and the City through the next decade. An approved master plan will provide the City with a "road map" for implementing a capital improvements program for phasing and funding necessary park enhancements.

The City invites you to attend the Whitemarsh Park Master Plan presentation on December 7 at 7:00 p.m. in the Multi-purpose Room at Bowie City Hall, located at 2614 Kenhill Drive, Bowie, MD 20715. After the presentation, residents will have the opportunity to provide input on the plan presented by the City's Consultant.
