New art exhibits at Bowie City Hall for the month of November include the work of students from Heather Hills Elementary School and the photography of the Bowie-Crofton Camera Club. The two exhibits will be on display until the end of November.

The Bowie-Crofton Camera Club traces its roots back to the “Bowie Photo Club” which was formed in the late 1960s. Currently the club has over 150 members who exhibit regularly in the metro area. The Young Person’s Art Gallery, which is a joint effort of the City’s Arts and Education Committees, features students’ artwork. The Young Person’s Art Gallery is located in the entrance foyer to Bowie City Hall, 2614 Kenhill Drive, and the City Hall Art Gallery that features the Bowie-Crofton Camera Club is located along the hallways of the building.

The galleries, along with the City’s other two galleries, the Visions of Bowie Gallery and the Conference Room Gallery, are open during City Hall hours, 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday and 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturday.
