Women's History Month Program for Young Ladies

In celebration of Women's History Month in March, the Belair Mansion in Bowie, MD., will host "According to the Ladies," a history program for ladies (and gentlemen!) of all ages.

Built in 1745, Belair Mansion has been the home of many strong and interesting women. On March 26, from Noon – 4:00 p.m. four women from the past will return to share their stories and their lives with visitors to the Mansion.

The journey through Belair Mansion will be a journey through time, with ladies from the 18th, 19th and 20th century present to discuss their lives, your lives --- and the differences between them. What choices did they have...what choices did they make? How are they different from ladies of today – and how are they the same? Discuss families, clothing, food, amusements, fears and tears! A time travel passport will be issued to all participants. A patch is available for Girl Scout groups. The cost is \$2 per patch; admission to the program is free.
