
CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND HVAC Equipment Replacement INVITATION TO BID

The City of Bowie, Maryland is requesting sealed bids for the removal and replacement of various heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system (HVAC) components and equipment at three City facilities (the "Project"). The work will be completed in two phases and will take place at the Bowie Gymnasium and Bowie Senior Center (Phase 1) and the Kenhill Center (Phase 2). The services performed shall be in accordance with the construction plans and specifications, and bid documents. The City of Bowie reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to reduce or modify the maintenance standards.

A bid security in the amount of 5% of the total bid amount in the form of a bid bond, bank draft, cashier's check or certified check made payable to the City of Bowie, Maryland shall accompany this bid. Performance and Payment bonds will be required.
