

RESOLUTION  
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND  
AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR GOVERNMENT RELATIONS  
REPRESENTATIVE/LOBBYIST

WHEREAS, actions taken by the Maryland General Assembly and the State's Executive Branch significantly affect the City of Bowie; and

WHEREAS, as one of the largest cities in the State of Maryland, the City has an interest in a range of legislative issues and public policy matters; and

WHEREAS, effective representation of the City's interests requires additional resources beyond the elected and appointed leadership of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the City's best interest to retain a Government Relations Representative/Lobbyist for Fiscal Year 2009; and

WHEREAS, Leonard Lucchi of O'Malley, Miles, Nylen & Gilmore, P.A. performed such services in Fiscal Year 2008; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lucchi was initially selected following an Intent to Negotiate process as authorized in Section 61 of the City Charter during which five proposals were received; and

WHEREAS, year-round representation in Annapolis will be valuable to promote the City's interests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bowie, Maryland, that a contract for \$46,000 for Government Relations Representative/Lobbyist services be awarded to O'Malley, Miles, Nylen & Gilmore, P.A. for the full Fiscal Year of 2009.
