Subject: Bid for Four Replacement Doors at the Water Plant

Legal notices were placed and bid packages were sent to various firms for four replacement doors at the Water Plant. Bids were opened and publicly read on October 14, 2008. The following is a tabulation of the bids received:

Foxcrafters Glenelg, MD	\$10,852.40
Tito Contractors, Inc. Washington, DC	15,888.00

This project is to replace the existing exterior doors at the Water Plant with new aluminum and glass, exterior doors. After a careful review of the bid proposals submitted, it was determined that Foxcrafters of Glenelg, MD, had submitted the most responsive, responsible bid in the amount of \$10,852.40, which is slightly over the budgeted amount for this item. There are, however, adequate funds in this account to cover the overage of \$852.40.

I concur with the above recommendation and request your approval of R-76-08.
