Legal notices were placed and bid packages were sent to selected firms for the construction of street and storm drainage improvements on 5th Street from Chestnut Avenue to 200' west. This project is being done in accordance with the City's five (5) year consolidated plan which identifies various streets to receive improvements in the Huntington Section. This project is being funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Community Development Block Grant Program, as well as Maryland's Department of Housing and Community Development's Community Legacy Program and Prince George's County's Livable Initiative grant program.

At the close of bidding at 11:00 a.m., Thursday, April 16, 2009, seven (7) bid proposals were received. Below is a tabulation of the bid proposals:
