OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND
RECOGNIZING ELEANOR T. MINOR FOR HER SERVICE TO THE
PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Eleanor Minor received a B.S. and a M.S. in Music Education at the University of Maryland, College Park; and

WHEREAS, during her service at Bowie High School, Eleanor Minor was awarded the Prince George's County Teacher of the Year in 1993, the Wolf Trap Foundation for the Performing Arts Grant for 2005-2006, and the WalMart Teacher of the Year in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Eleanor Minor has taught the Chamber Choir, the Concert Choir, Music Theater 1, Music Theater 2, Basic/Intermediate Guitar, Basic Intermediate Piano, and Advanced Piano at Bowie High School; and

WHEREAS, Eleanor Minor has produced and directed 16 Spring Musical Productions, including West Side Story, Grease, How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying; High School Musical and the 2009 production of All Shook Up.
