Subject: Ordinance O-9-09 - Supplemental Appropriation for the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2010.

DATE: September 17, 2009

Ordinance O-9-09 provides a supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, to fund the replacement of the exterior stair case at the Railroad Museum Tower.

The existing exterior metal stair case at the Railroad Museum Tower has deteriorated and has been closed to the public. The City Council recently approved Resolution R-58-09, awarding a contract for the replacement of the exterior stair case at the Railroad Museum Tower. Funding for this project was previously approved by Ordinance 0-3-09 amending the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2009 and shall be rolled over to the current fiscal year.

Council's approval of Ordinance O-9-09 providing supplemental appropriation for the annual budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, is requested.

**ORDINANCE  
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND  
PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE ANNUAL  
BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2010  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE EXTERIOR  
METAL STAIR CASE AT THE RAILROAD MUSEUM**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Bowie (hereinafter, "Council") adopted Ordinance Number O-1-09 appropriating funds for the several objects and purposes for which the City had to provide for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2010; and,

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 45 of the Charter of the City of Bowie (hereinafter, the "City") no public money may be expended without having been appropriated by the Council; and,

**WHEREAS**, supplemental appropriations are necessary to appropriate new or additional sources of revenue not included in Ordinance Number O-1-09; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council annually adopts a six-year Capital Improvements Program which identifies the capital projects to be undertaken by the City and the estimated costs associated with each project; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council approved Ordinance O-3-09 to fund the replacement of the exterior stair case in the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, it has become necessary to appropriate funds for the replacement of the exterior metal stair case at the Railroad Museum Tower.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Bowie, Maryland:

Section 1: That the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2010, adopted by Ordinance Number O-1-09, be and is hereby amended to as follows:
