SUBJECT: Cathodic Protection – Bradford Lane Ground Water Tank

Legal notices were placed and bid packages were sent to selected firms for modifications, cathodic protection system installation, spot cleaning and spot coating to the 3,000,000 gallon steel ground water tank on Media Lane. At the close of bidding at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 15, 2009, three (3) bid proposals were received. Below is a tabulation of the bid proposals:

S & T Painting, Inc. Parkton, Maryland	\$36,200
J & W of North Carolina, Inc. Vanceboro, North Carolina	\$38,000
Superior Industrial Maintenance Company Harrisburg, North Carolina	\$49,971

This work is being done in accordance with the Capital Improvement Program for water storage tanks. A total of \$75,000 was budgeted for cathodic protection. Cathodic protection is an effective method of controlling erosion of metal surfaces. It involves the installation of low voltage current connections to the steel in strategic locations to retard corrosion.

The Public Works Department recommends that the bid proposal from S & T Painting, Inc., in the amount of \$36,200, be accepted.

I concur with the above recommendation to award to S & T Painting, Inc., in the amount of \$36,200, and request your approval of R-5-10.
