SUBJECT: Electrical Upgrade at Pump Station #8

Legal notices were placed and bid packages were sent to selected firms for an electrical upgrade at pump station #8. At the close of bidding at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 9, 2010, one bid proposal had been received from Kroeger Electric Company in the amount of \$75,500.

This work is being performed in accordance with the Capital Improvement Program for the Wastewater Treatment Plant. In FY09, due to equipment failure at pump station #2, the decision was made to hold off on pump station #8 until FY11. However, this is not indicated in the current budget. Although the bid amount exceeds the budgeted amount by \$3,500, there are sufficient funds in the Machinery and Equipment fund.

The Public Works Department recommends that the bid proposal from Kroeger Electric Company, in the amount of \$75,500, be accepted.

I concur with the above recommendation to award to Kroeger Electric Company in the amount of \$75,500 and request your approval of R-12-10.
