

RESOLUTION
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO EKE, LLC FOR THE DESIGN, FABRICATION
AND INSTALLATION OF A KINETIC SCULPTURE
FOR THE NEW CITY HALL

WHEREAS, the City of Bowie has enacted an Art in Public Places policy to promote and encourage public art in the City of Bowie; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowie desires to create two public art pieces for the new City Hall, one a kinetic sculpture (also known as a mobile) and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) for a kinetic artist to design, fabricate and install a kinetic sculpture in the lobby of the new Bowie City Hall; and

WHEREAS, from the respondents, three finalists were selected for an interview, and the Panel chose the design submitted by EKE, LLC for the public art to be displayed in the new Bowie City Hall; and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2010, the City Council approved the design submitted by EKE, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowie desires to enter into a contract with EKE, LLC to design, fabricate and install the kinetic sculpture in accordance with the requirements of the RFQ and the renderings and written description attached hereto as Exhibit A for a total amount not to exceed Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Bowie awards the contract for the kinetic sculpture for the new Bowie City Hall to EKE, LLC for a total amount not to exceed \$80,000;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with EKE, LLC in accordance herewith in a form satisfactory to the City.
