OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND
RECOGNIZING LT. MICHAEL D. CLEVELAND ON HIS

WHEREAS, from November, 2009 to the time of his retirement, Lt. Cleveland served in Police Personnel/Risk Management.
