Subject: Ordinance O-7-10 – Amending the Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2010, and Ending June 30, 2011

DATE: July 29, 2010

During fiscal year 2009, Council endorsed the Senior Citizens Housing Rehabilitation and “Green” Technologies Demonstration Program. Funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Open Door Housing Fund, the program provides financial assistance to low and moderate income seniors for home improvements and repairs. The program is currently underway having identified ten households that qualified to participate in the program.

Ordinance O-7-10 amends the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011, to acknowledge the award of the grants and provide a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$608,000 to fund the Senior Citizens Housing Rehabilitation and “Green” Technologies Demonstration Program.

Funding for this project was previously approved by Ordinance 0-1-09 amending the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2010 and shall be rolled over to the current fiscal year.

Council’s approval of Ordinance O-7-10 amending the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011, to provide a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$608,000 is requested.

ORDINANCE
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND
AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING
JULY 1, 2010, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2011, AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE O-3-
10, AS AMENDED, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE SENIOR CITIZENS
HOUSING REHABILITATION AND “GREEN” TECHNOLOGIES
DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bowie (hereinafter, “Council”) adopted Ordinance Number O-3-10 appropriating funds for the several objects and purposes for which the City had to provide for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 45 of the Charter of the City of Bowie (hereinafter, the “City”) no public money may be expended without having been appropriated by the Council; and,

WHEREAS, the City has been designated as a recipient of federal funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development in the amount of \$383,000 and \$225,000 for the Open Door Housing Fund,

WHEREAS, amendments to the City’s adopted Budget are necessary to reflect the receipt of the aforementioned funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Open Door Housing Fund and to appropriate the revenue, as it was not included in Ordinance O-3-10 or any amendments thereto.

Section 1. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of the City of Bowie, Maryland that the Budget for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2010, and Ending June 30, 2011, as adopted by Ordinance O-3-10 and amended by O-7-10, be and is hereby amended to appropriate the following amounts as supplements thereto:
