Legal notices were placed and bid packages were sent to selected firms for the purchase of a street sweeper. At the close of bidding at 11:00 a.m., Thursday, August 26, 2010, three (3) bid proposals were received. Below is a tabulation of the bid proposals:

Atlantic Machinery, Inc. Silver Spring, Maryland	\$165,121
Maryland Industrial Trucks, Inc. Linthicum, Maryland	\$172,008
Mid-Atlantic Waste Systems Clinton, Maryland	\$180,275

The street sweeper is being purchased in accordance with the Equipment Acquisition and Replacement Schedule for FY11.

The Public Works Department recommends that the bid proposal from Atlantic Machinery, Inc., in the amount of \$165,121, be accepted. The budget for the replacement vehicle is \$170,000.

I concur with the above recommendation to award to Atlantic Machinery, Inc., in the amount of \$165,121, and request your approval of R-60-10.
