

RESOLUTION

OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND
ACCEPTING BID PROPOSALS FOR
PERSONAL COMPUTERS

WHEREAS, The City Council has authorized the acquisition of 73 personal computers in fiscal year 2011; and

WHEREAS, The 73 personal computers are replacements for existing struggling and aged equipment and for placement in the new city hall; and

WHEREAS, The city requested proposals for all personal computers; and

WHEREAS, Requests were posted to the eMaryland Marketplace web site as required by law; and

WHEREAS, Advertisements were placed in local newspapers and request for bid proposals were sent to twenty two firms; and

WHEREAS, All equipment requested is standard 'off the shelf' product; and

WHEREAS, At the close of bidding on August 20, 2010, ten bids had been received; and

WHEREAS, Decsivse Data Systems, Inc. submitted the most responsive bid proposal for 73 computers that met the City's specifications, with a total price of \$38,102.35.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bowie, Maryland, that the Council accept the proposal of Decsivse Data Systems, Inc. for the purchase of 73 personal computers, and that the City Manager is authorized to purchase from Decsivse Data Systems, Inc., 3445 C Box Hill Corporate Center Drive, Abingdon, Maryland 73 personal computers in the amount of \$38,102.35.
