### *Status Report*

1. Transportation Land-Use Connections (TLC) Grant Approval

The City was successful in obtaining \$30,000 in funding assistance from the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Transportation Planning Board (TPB) for a feasibility study for a pedestrian overpass over MD 214. The project will examine pedestrian safety and access alternatives in the vicinity of MD 214 and Hall Road and provide planning level construction cost estimates. The goal is to explore ways to implement a portion of the City's proposed Trails Master Plan route connecting the Pointer Ridge area to the new South Lake development, south of MD 214. These improvements are a key segment of "The Bowie Byway" identified in the Trails Master Plan and will link to the County's master planned trail system within South Lake, providing access to the Liberty Sports Park and eventually, Upper Marlboro. The consultant study will begin this fall and conclude by June, 2021.
