A legal notice advertising a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Pin Oak and Hall Road Drainage Basin Repair Project was placed on eMaryland Marketplace and on the City's website on December 3, 2021. Bids were received from the following firms on January 6, 2022:

The bids were evaluated as required by City Charter and the Procurement Policy. Criteria for selection included the firm's experience, qualifications, timeline, fee schedule and understanding of the City requirements.

After careful review, it was determined that Environmental Quality Resources, LLC of Millersville, MD had submitted the most responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$130,531.25. This project will be funded through the FY22 Budget under the CIP for Chesapeake Bay.
