## SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT

On March 5, 2012 at 23:15 hours, while in a marked patrol vehicle Officer Booth observed the operator of a blue 1990 Plymouth Minivan turn left with out using proper signal. It was at this time Officer Booth conducted a traffic stop. The occupant of the vehicle Mr. John Winfield had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. Mr. Winfield refused to be subjected to any Standardized Field Sobriety Test. However, while on scene Mr. Winfield openly admitted to being intoxicated and asked for officers to come and get him. In his vehicle Mr. Winfield had an 18 pack of Corona bottles, an empty bottle of El Padrino Tequila and a red cup in the driver's side cup holder containing a clear liquid suspected to be an alcoholic beverage.

Mr. Winfield was placed into custody and transported to the Department of Corrections, where he was processed and issued several citations.
