Status Report

1. Prescription Drug Take Back

The Bowie Police Department has scheduled another Prescription Drug Take Back for Saturday, May 16th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Drop offs can be made at the Bowie Police Department.

2. Economic Development Committee (EDC)

The Bowie EDC held their regular meeting Wednesday. Two new EDC members, Elliott and Ragland, were welcomed. Tomika Monterville, the Chief, Transit Division at Prince George's County DPWT briefed the members on County transportation services in Bowie; this briefing was an updated version of the one given to the City Council last October. Joe Meinert explained the City's current transportation policy positions, as expressed in Council letters to the County and State.

The next regular meeting of the EDC will be Wednesday, April 8, 2015 at 7:30 a.m.

3. Bond Bill

The Bond Bill for the Senior Center (HB1278) upgrades is expected to be heard Saturday at 11:00 a.m. by the House Appropriations Committee. Bond Bills for Champ House (HB1212) and the Knights of St. John (HB314) are also scheduled at the same time.

4. District Council Results: Melford Conceptual Site Plan

On Monday, March 9, 2015 the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, voted 8-1 (Lehman opposed) to APPROVE the Conceptual Site Plan for Melford Village submitted by St. John Properties. Oral Argument was heard on February 23rd and the District Council took the case under advisement. In their action this week, the District Council directed that an Order of Approval with conditions be prepared and brought back for a final vote at their March 23rd meeting.
