SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: Officer Curry, of the Bowie Police Department, conducted a follow up investigation of a 1st Degree Assault that occurred in the 3600 block of Elder Oaks Blvd. In this assault the suspect approached the victim and demanded he cease working on a fence designed to stop foot traffic from the apartment complex to the Collington Shopping Center. When the victim refused to stop work the suspect pulled a semi auto handgun and threatened to the victim. Officer Curry was able to identify a possible suspect. Officer Curry with the assistance of Det Polk, Bowie Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division, was then able to obtain an arrest warrant for the suspect and a search and seizure warrant for his residence. On 4-6-12 at about 0700 hours members of the Prince George's County Police Emergency Services Team made entry into the residence. The suspect was located inside and taken into custody without incident. During the execution of the search warrant a loaded 380 cal. handgun was recovered.
