SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On the above listed time, date and location, Bowie Police units responded to the Bank of America for a report of a robbery. Upon arrival, Bowie Police units were advised that the suspects (both believed to be males) entered the location armed and demanded money from the bank employees. The bank employees complied with the demands and the suspects fled in an unknown direction. A canvass of the area was conducted which yielded negative results. There were no reported injuries as a result of this incident.

The Prince George’s County Police and FBI (Baltimore Field Office) responded to the scene and assumed the investigation.
