SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On April 18, 2015 at approximately 0324 hours, Bowie officers responded to the 12700 block of 10th Street, Bowie, MD 20720 for a report of an automobile accident. Upon arrival, the officer observed a Gold Honda Civic which had left the roadway and crashed into an antique cannon and flag pole in the City of Bowie Veterans Memorial Park. Upon making contact with the driver, officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. The driver also had bloodshot and glassy eyes and slurred speech. The driver produced his Maryland issued driver's license and was identified. Suspecting that citizen was under the influence of alcohol, Bowie officers subjected him to a set of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests which he failed. The citizen was then placed under arrest for suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol and read his DR-15 Advice of Rights form. At this point, he refused to submit to an alcohol concentration test and was taken to the Bowie Police station where he was issued multiple traffic citations and released. Nothing further.
