SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On April 23, 2012 at approximately 2:00PM, Officer Anderson was conducting a premise check in the Lowe's parking lot in reference to several theft from autos and a robbery in recent weeks. During the premise check Officer Anderson observed a green Volvo matching the description from the previous thefts and attempted to make a traffic stop to identify the occupants. The driver of the vehicle refused to stop initially causing Officer Anderson to follow him until the vehicle came to a stop at the 3500blk of Crain Hwy. At this point Officer Anderson and assisting Officers were able to place both subjects in custody. A vehicle inventory revealed several tools in the backseat. A short time later a victim was identified at the Lowe's stating his work van had been broken into and tools matching his were in A1's vehicle. Both subjects were transported to the Bowie Police Station for questioning on the previous thefts.
