INCIDENT: Handgun Arrest w/ Burglary Closure

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On May 28th, 2015, Bowie Police Officers were conducting a follow-up investigation attempting to locate a runaway juvenile who was reportedly armed with a handgun. The juvenile was reported as a missing person on May 27th, 2015 and was believed to still be in the Bowie area. Bowie Police Officers conducted a thorough and extensive canvass, gathering information from acquaintances of the juvenile. At approximately 1952 hours on May 28th, Bowie Police Officers located the juvenile subject in the 3000 block of Belair Drive. The juvenile subject was taken into custody and a loaded 9mm handgun was recovered. The juvenile subject was arrested and transported to Bowie Police Department to be interviewed by Det. Wuthrich of the Criminal Investigations Unit. After being Mirandized and interviewed, the juvenile subject was discovered to have also been involved in a residential burglary that was reported on May 23rd, 2015 in the 3600 block of Violetwood Place. The juvenile subject was charged and then transported to Cheltenham Youth Facility in Cheltenham, Maryland.
