SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On July 2nd, 2015 at approximately 2248 hours, Bowie Police Officers responded to the area of 3000 New Oak Lane in reference to a threats complaint. Upon arrival, Officers learned that a subject was making threats to set fire to a residence and shoot everyone with a 9mm. The involved subject was known to the Officers on scene and was a wanted subject. The wanted subject had three open warrants through Prince George's County Sheriffs Office and was wanted in connection with attempted arson from the night prior at the same location. Bowie Police Officers canvassed the area for the subject and then established a perimeter. Maryland State Police responded to assist with a K-9 unit and several saturation units along with Prince George's County Police aviation unit. Additional attempts were made to locate the subject and an address on Queen Anne Bridge Road was obtained. As some Officers began to clear from New Oak Lane and divert towards Queen Anne Bridge Road, the subject returned to New Oak Lane and broke out a rear sliding glass door to the residence. Bowie Officers still on scene of New Oak Lane located the subject and apprehended him after a brief foot pursuit. No one was injured as a result of the incident. The subject was transported to Department of Corrections and charged accordingly.
