SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On July 12, 2015 at 2250hrs, Corporal Vargas observed a suspicious vehicle parked in front of 4901 Collington Road (Benjamin Tasker Middle School). Upon further investigation it was discovered that the vehicle (black Audi) was occupied by Arrested 1 who advised that he was having vehicle issues. Bowie Officers attempted to assist Arrested 1 with his vehicle when an alarm from the school sounded. Bowie Officers on scene immediately conducted a visual inspection of the front of the school and discovered a broken window. Bowie Officers established an outer perimeter and made notification to PGCPD K9 Sgt. McKinniss who responded. Bowie Officers were able to gain entry into the school and conducted a search, in which Arrested 2 was discovered inside the school without authorization. It was later determined that Arrested 1 was assisting Arrested 2 as a lookout. Both suspects were taken into custody and charged accordingly.
