INCIDENT: Attempt 1st Degree Murder

LOCATION: 3000 block of Belair Drive, Bowie, MD 20715

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: October 10th, 2015 at 1120 hours

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On October 10th, 2015 at 1120 hours, Bowie Police Officers received a call for a shooting in the 3000 block of Belair Drive, Bowie, MD 20715. Upon arrival, Officers met with several witnesses who advised that they observed two male suspects traveling at a high rate of speed in a white Nissan Frontier pickup truck in the 3000 block of Belair Drive. Witnesses stated that the victim began running down the sidewalk, at which time the Nissan truck left the roadway and intentionally struck the victim. The suspects then pulled out a handgun and fired at least once towards the subject who was fleeing from the suspect. Officers recovered the spent round, a 9mm bullet, from the shooting incident; that bullet was recovered from inside an occupied residence in the 2900 block of Tallow Lane, Bowie, MD. During a canvass for the suspect and the victim, Officers located the white Nissan Frontier in the driveway of a residence in the 12400 block of Shawmont Lane. Officers made contact with three male subjects, all of whom were transported to the Bowie Police Station to be interviewed by Detective Sgt. Rodriguez. The Nissan Frontier was impounded to the CBPD station where it was processed by CBPD Evidence. From the interviews, Sgt. Rodriguez was able to identify the victim. Officers then located the victim at the Safeway off of Northview Drive; he too was interviewed by Detective Sgt. Rodriguez. Written statements were secured and the suspects were identified. Det. Sgt. Rodriguez, Sgt. Bell, Cpl. Arnold and PFC Magnuson then proceeded to locate the suspects and made apprehension. Two suspects were taken into police custody and transported to Upper Marlboro Department of Corrections where charges were obtained for attempt 1st Degree Murder along with other related charges.
