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PREFACE
The Recreation Master Plan 2005 - 2010

The Recreation Master Plan 2005-2010 was developed from the 1996-2005 Recreation Master Plan. This Master Plan is intended for use by the City staff, planner, developers, and users in developing recreational facilities and programs over the next ten years. The approach was to identify and review all of the recreational facilities available in 2005 within the City of Bowie and adjacent areas. These facilities included those owned by the City of Bowie, the Maryland-National Capital Park, and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC), Board of Education, private clubs, homeowners associations, and commercial businesses. The facilities are identified and grouped by area: Area I consists essentially of Northridge and the Huntington section of old Bowie; Area II is Bowie north of US Route 50, and Area III is Bowie south of US 50. By taking the current population of each area, the ratio of facilities to population was developed. This ratio was then compared with the planning standards used by M-NCPPC, which in turn were based in part upon national standards available in National Recreation and Parks Association guidelines. The Plan also compared the number of facilities available in Bowie with four other comparable communities: Annapolis, Columbia, Gaithersburg and Laurel.

Based upon the experience achieved in over 20 years of allocating facilities to user groups within the City of Bowie, and utilizing the collective judgment of the Community Recreation Committee (CRC), recommended ratios of facilities to population were developed.

Using these recommended ratios and utilizing population projections, the requirements for future recreation facilities were projected. When compared with existing facilities and those additional facilities anticipated to be available before 2010, a net deficiency or surplus was identified for each activity, each area and for the entire City. Table VI identifies surpluses/deficiencies for 2005 and Table XIV identifies those for 2010. These tables confirm and support CRC's continuing position with respect to the need for additional baseball/softball fields, soccer fields and indoor gyms. The most pressing need City-wide is for gymnasium facilities for indoor activities, lacrosse fields, lighted soccer fields and football fields.

In the General Recreation Guidelines, conclusions from the needs analysis are summarized. Immediate and long-range needs are identified and recommendations made for practices and policies regarding overlay fields, complexing, and small area usage. Field enhancements such as lighting and irrigation are addressed, and suggestions for use management are provided. And finally, an alert is given to maintain a watchful eye on community needs and future trends to stay abreast of changing recreational requirements.

This Plan would not be complete without acknowledging the effort by the City of Bowie to address the recreational needs of the community. The appendixes in this document address a substantial inventory of recreational facilities, within or adjacent to the City, which currently exist and are available for community use. The list identifies 111 different properties which contain recreational facilities, and which represent over three dozen different types of activities. Of these properties, 21 have been provided by the City, 15 by the M-NCPPC, and 18 by the Board of Education and 57 churches, private or commercial organizations.

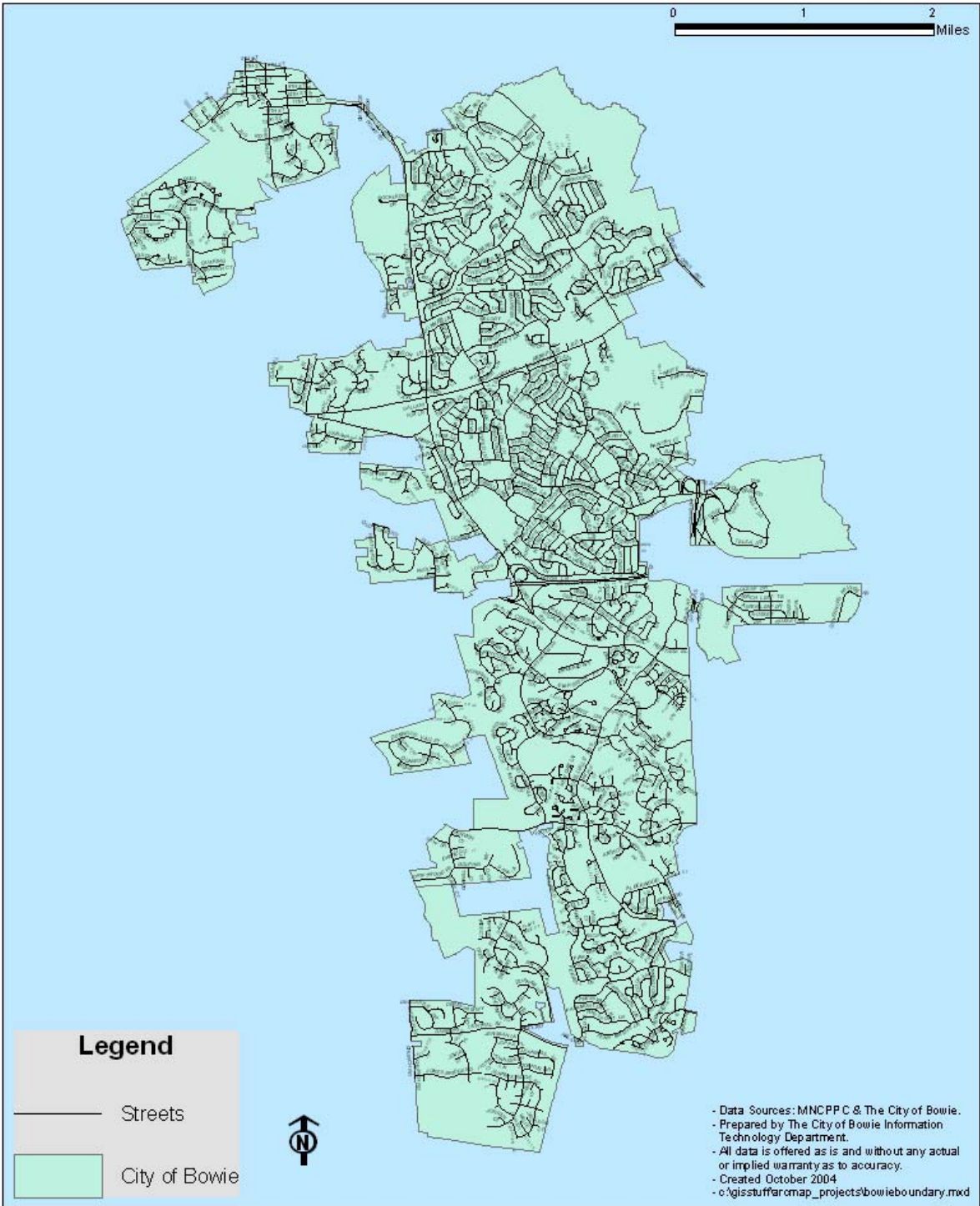
Further, in Tables III and IV where per capita ratios of facilities to population are provided, Bowie compares exceptionally well when compared to both M-NCPPC standards and comparable communities. Against M-NCPPC standards, Bowie exceeds those standards in 9 of 13 comparisons - 69% of the categories. Against comparable cities' ratios, Bowie exceeds those ratios in 16 of 19 comparisons, or 84% of the categories.

Development has been on-going throughout the preparation of the Plan, and the recreational environment has been and will continue to be, dynamic and changing. The data in the Plan represent the best known status for the end of 2005. Accordingly, some of the anticipated facilities in Tables IX and X, which once were projections, have since been added to the inventory. Examples include amenities at the Ensleigh, New Town Center Park, and the Palisades sections of the City.

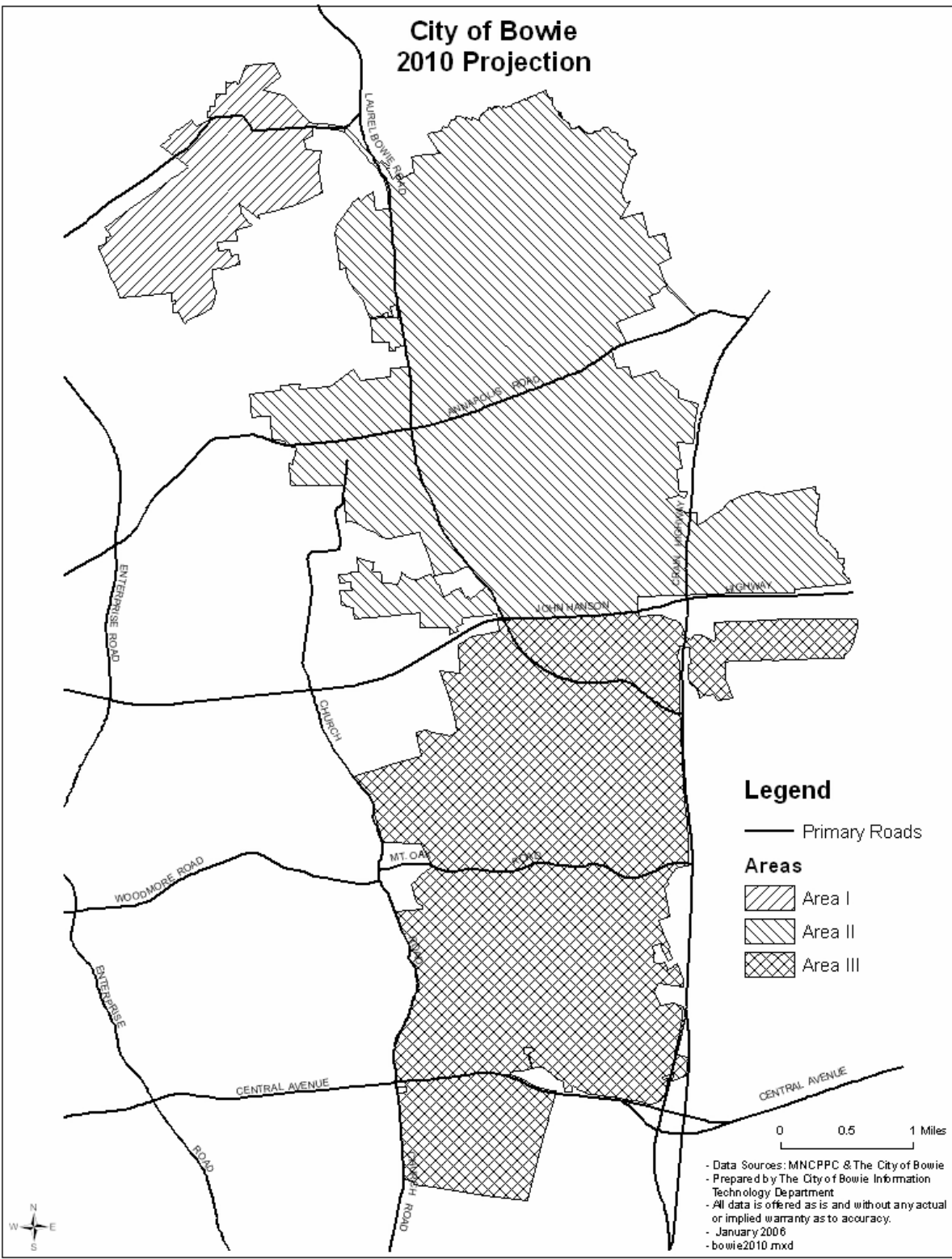
As this report was being concluded, efforts by the City already were underway to address shortfalls known to exist in the inventory, and as identified in the Plan. Of particular note are recent developments and actions, which will make possible the construction of a Skateboard Park.

Clearly, the City is making considerable effort to address the recreational needs of its community, and is to be commended for its positive attitude toward recreation, the progress and accomplishments to date, and its commitment to continued support of these interests.

2005 – 2010 RECREATION MASTER PLAN

OVERVIEW

The Recreation Master Plan consists of a series of tables which compare recreational facilities existing within the City of Bowie Planning Area in 2005 and those projected to exist in 2010 against the City population for those respective years.

For ease of reference, a description of each of the tables in the 2005-2010 Recreation Master Plan is provided either in a text block on the table itself or preceding the respective table in the plan. The order in which material in this plan was developed differs from its placement in the document. This is so because information which was essential to the preparation of the plan, but which, *because of its detail or particular format*, was not relevant to the requirements analysis itself, was relegated to appendixes where it would remain available for reference and use by those who would benefit from its content specifically the Community Recreation Committee, the Recreation Office, The Planning Staff and members of the community.

The Master Plan effort commenced with the development of a comprehensive inventory of the various recreational facilities within the City of Bowie, or adjacent to the City and typically available to residents of the community at the beginning of 2005. Properties listed include those owned by the City of Bowie, Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the Prince George's County Board of Education and by private organizations including clubs, churches, and homeowner associations. This inventory of **2005 Facilities** can be found in **Appendix A1**, where it is sorted alphabetically by the facility name, and again in **Appendix A2**, where it is sorted alphabetically by type of activity.

The data in Appendix A2 next were summarized to detail the number of facilities in the inventory, by activity, for each of the three population areas within the City and to the City as a whole, and placed in **Appendix A3**.

Using the numerical data in Appendix A3, a table then was developed to show the **ratio of those numbers** (Quantity), for each activity, **to the population** for each of the three areas of the City and to the City as a whole. These data are contained in **Appendix A4**, and are the source of the baseline format for the majority of tables contained in this Plan. From Appendix A4, a subset (short list) of activities was selected as the top 20 areas of interest for active recreation by Bowie citizens.

The population figures used in Appendix A4, and in all subsequent tables of this Plan, were generated from housing and population estimates provided by the City of Bowie Department of Planning and Economic Development. These data can be found in **Table I – Housing Estimates** and **Table II – Population Estimates**. The population estimates for 2005 and 2010 are used as the **current year** and **target year** for the Plan, and are a component of all ratios generated for this study. The 2010 figures include population for developments outside the Bowie city limits,

where children of residents attend Bowie schools or within geographic boundaries for Bowie and South Bowie Boys and Girls Club.

As a preliminary step in the development of the plan, an attempt was made to see how the City of Bowie compared against other Maryland localities with similar demographic characteristics. Accordingly, the ratios of the subset of activities selected from Appendix A4 were carried forward into **Table III – Comparison of Bowie Ratios to Other Cities**, and compared to four comparable localities: Annapolis, Columbia, Gaithersburg and Laurel; and to the average ratios for those four localities.

Despite considerable time and effort, the CRC found it very difficult to obtain truly comparable data for the whole subset of selected activities. This was due in part to the fact that data were not available for all activities in all the localities, but largely because the use and management of resources were found to vary within and among the various cities, and that none were consistent with the consolidated approach used by the City of Bowie Recreation Office. Although the data in this table were not considered completely reliable for making desired comparisons, it was felt that the **average ratios** would be a useful tool in developing subsequent recommendations in the Plan, and that the table itself provided value-added information useful to both the Recreation Office and to the Department of Planning and Economic Development.

Table IV – Recommended Ratios by Activity compares the Bowie ratios for 2005 (from Table III) with the Average Ratios for Comparable Cities (from Table III) and with standards used by the M-NCPPC, where available. The M-NCPPC standards are developed from guidelines and formulas generated by the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA) (see Facility Standards, page viii). In Table IV, recommendations are made for the current year 2005, and for the year 2010. For 2005, **quantities** first were adjusted where current shortfalls were felt to exist, and the **recommended ratios** then calculated. Assuming those adjusted 2005 ratios to be satisfactory (in most cases), they were carried forward to 2010 where they then were used to calculate the **recommended quantities** for that year (again, in most cases).

The recommended quantities and ratios for 2005 are a subjective assessment by the Community Recreation Committee of what a reasonable proportion of resources to population **ought to be for the current year** based on those comparisons, but adjusted or modified where experience with particular activities dictate. The recommended numbers are judgmental, but this approach is considered consistent with the current consensus of recreational planners in using NRPA facility standards. These recommendations are based on current experience with the recreational environment of Bowie at the time of this study. Likewise, the numbers for 2010 are a best estimate based on the current inventory of facilities, programmatic requirements of the user community, and the anticipated population growth.

Table V – 2005 Facilities Requirements by Activity is an expansion of 2005 Recommendations in Table IV. The data in this table represent the **quantity** (number) of facilities required in 2005 for each of the activities listed – for each area of the City and the total required City-wide and is calculated by dividing the Population Estimates of Table II by the Recommended 2005 Ratios in Table IV.

Table VI – 2005 Facilities Surpluses/Deficiencies by Activity next was derived by subtracting the quantity (number) of **facilities required** in Table V from the quantity (number) of **existing**

facilities in Appendix A4. **The data are differences which show where either a shortfall exists [negative numbers], or where a surplus exists [positive numbers].**

Table VII – 2010 Projected Facilities Requirements and Table VIII – 2005 Preliminary Facilities Surpluses/Deficiencies are the 2010 equivalent of Tables V and VI above. Table VIII shows where shortfalls are projected to exist in 2010 prior to the addition of any projected amenities from future development, and thus is a “**preliminary**” assessment of those shortfalls.

In **Table IX – Anticipated Facilities Additions**, facilities are listed that are projected to be added to or removed from the existing inventory by 2010 as a result of committed construction projects. The potential loss of soccer fields on Mitchellville Road due to the new high school was not included in the inventory in Appendix A1. Table IX lists this information by facility, and **Table X** by activity. These data are summarized in **Table XI – Summary of Anticipated Facility Additions**, and placed in the format of previous tables.

Table XII – 2010 Anticipated Facilities Surpluses/Deficiencies represents the effect on the **preliminary data for 2010** in table VIII of adding the **anticipated additions** summarized in Table XI. It is critical table in that it shows the facilities that can be counted on being available for use in 2010.

Table XIII – M-NCPPC Potential Facility Additions for Population Growth represents the **minimum quantity** of facilities recommended by the M-NCPPC to serve the projected increases in population in Bowie. It is developed from M-NCPPC facilities guidelines used to specify specific numbers of recreational facilities that are expected to be provided by development projects based on the population that the project will generate. The data in this table are added to the anticipated deficiencies/surpluses in Table XII to generate **Table XIV**.

The final table, **Table XIV – 2010 Net Facilities Surplus/Deficiencies by Activity**, reflects the **total increases and losses to the facilities inventory** as a result of all known, anticipated or potential development in the City of Bowie.

Appendix B – Organized Activities, is provided for information only as a reference list of all existing organizations which currently use facilities in the City of Bowie. The numbers for 2005 represent the minimum use of facilities. All non-organized unscheduled or off-season uses of the facilities are considered to be additive, and are not included. Predictions for 2010 are those of user representatives based on the current (2005) growth patterns of the respective organizations and do not necessarily reflect the population growth predictions of this study.

Appendix C – Suggested Facility Development Standards, extracts from NRPA publications, recommendations for the amount of space required for those facilities listed, plus size, dimension and orientation information. The NRPA also provides detailed requirements for parking in recreational areas, and those standards considered to be appropriate for the scope of this report are included. More detailed information can be found in the referenced NRPA publications, if needed.

Appendix D – Technical Description, contains information which describes technical aspects of the preparation of this Plan, and is intended for use by those who must maintain and update the material in the document.

GENERAL RECREATION GUIDELINES

1. NEEDS ANALYSIS:

The most pressing recreational needs that should be addressed by the City include gymnasium space for indoor activities, and athletic fields for softball, baseball, soccer, football, and lacrosse. The deficiencies existing in 2005 are identified in Table VI. Those projected to exist in 2010 based on the offsets due to anticipated and potential additions to the inventory are identified in Table XI. Table XII represents the NET deficiency remaining after the anticipated additions become a reality. The City must be aware that there is a short-term or immediate need to be addressed, as well as a long-range requirement which includes: (1) ensuring projected amenities are included in future development activities; and, (2) finding solutions to the remaining shortfalls. The immediate and long-range needs are summarized as follows:

IMMEDIATE NEEDS: (Those required to resolve the 2005 short-falls)

- The addition of at least one new multi-court gymnasium with a minimum of two courts for basketball and volleyball.
- The addition of at least one lighted football field, preferably in Area III.
- The addition of at least one lighted lacrosse field.
- The addition of two lighted soccer fields to satisfy the current need for practice during limited daylight hours in the Spring and Fall seasons.

LONG RANGE NEEDS: (Those that are over and above the projected additions)

- One additional football field, again, preferably in Area II.
- At least three additional lacrosse fields.

Tennis: The number of courts City-wide is sufficient for both the 2005 and 2010 populations. Should the projections for 2010 hold true, there would be an unnecessary excess of tennis courts in the Areas I and II of the City.

Playgrounds/tot lots: Figures for 2010 reveal a significant deficiency of these facilities in Area II. It should be noted that Area II is an older, more mature section of the City with limited growth potential, and there has been no citizen demand to address this shortfall. However, the demographic characteristic of Area II should continue to be monitored to determine if such a need is generated in the future.

2. OVERLAY FIELDS:

There are currently a number of overlay fields (i.e., fields that are designed for two or more activities). The overlaying of new fields should continue to be generally discouraged. Furthermore, overlay practice fields should be limited, while overlay game fields be discouraged altogether. (Overlay fields may be a more efficient use of recreational land, but fields need some degree of non-use. Also, the growing popularity of sports outside their primary season creates less of a problem of exclusive fields sitting idle off-season. Having a baseball pitcher's mound or an infield without turf precludes optimum use of a field for soccer or football.)

3. COMPLEXING:

- **GROUPING:** Encourage locating three or more fields into complexes that cater to only one or two activities, as this results in a more cost and time effective use of the fields. Examples are Blacksox

and Jericho Parks and Mitchellville Road Soccer. Complexing of fields provides optimum use of facilities, parking and scarce coaches. This is particularly important in the case of game fields.

- **DESIRABILITY OF POTENTIAL NEW COMPLEXES:** Among the sites for potential new field complexes that were determined to be desirable or feasible, the recommended order of preference would be:
FIRST CHOICE: Green Branch; SECOND CHOICE: Glen at Turf Farm; THIRD CHOICE: Sandy Hill Extension; FOURTH CHOICE: Saddlebrook West
- **EXISTING COMPLEXES:** The five existing major complexes (Allen Pond, Jericho Park, Church Road Park, Foxhill Park and Whitmarsh Park) are fully developed, and Sandy Hill needs to be completed.

4. SMALL AREAS:

Small parcels of open space afford an opportunity to provide areas for practice fields and game sites for small-sided soccer, and for activities such as halfcourt basketball, beach volleyball, street hockey, BMX and roller-blading, tot lots and passive activities for senior citizens. Such parcels should be considered candidates for satisfying these types of community interests on an as-needed basis.

5. IRRIGATION:

Due to the extended usage of outdoor fields, irrigation as a component of turf management and enhancing the turf should be considered and encouraged whenever practical and cost-effective. The use of artificial turf reduces the need for irrigation and relieves other maintenance needs particularly mowing and feeding.

6. LIGHTING:

Lighting outdoor facilities should be encouraged as it makes the facilities available to a greater number of users over longer periods. This is particularly true in early Spring and late Fall when there is not sufficient natural light for weekday activities. A significant trade-off, however, of lighting ballfields is the increased wear that not only hastens turf damage, but also impacts the implementation of turf management programs.

7. USE MANAGEMENT:

The City of Bowie has developed and implemented a turf management program for City-owned or leased ballfields. This program should be followed aggressively on existing fields, extended to include new additions to the inventory, and should be allowed to evolve as experience, knowledge and training are obtained. The desired objectives of the City program have been difficult to achieve, due in large part to the heavy demand for field use resulting in rapid and extreme wear.

Of all the outdoor activities, soccer and football cause the greatest wear and damage to playing fields. The very high user demand for use of the available properties for these activities has made it virtually impossible to have an effective turf management program, or to implement sound use-management policies. This problem needs to be addressed and remedies identified. For instance, the addition of sufficient fields for both activities would allow better use-management practices such as: designating practice only or game only sites; and/or, rotation of fields between periods of use and non-use (resting) for selected fields. The use of different turf grasses on irrigated and non-irrigated fields might improve resistance to drought. CRC strongly recommends the use of artificial turf for soccer, football, and lacrosse fields. Better use-management in turn leads to more effective turf management.

8. DETERMINATION OF COMBINATION AND TYPE OF FACILITIES:

Developers should be encouraged to provide recreational facilities in line with the needs and policies as stated in Table XII, so as to avoid creating further discrepancies between the types of facilities needed and the types of facilities available. If a developer is required or chooses to provide recreational facilities, the needs, phasing and locations delineated in this Plan should be applied in determining the combination and type of facilities best suited for that specific project.

9. FEE-IN-LIEU FUNDS FOR SPECIAL RECREATIONAL FACILITIES:

Whenever possible, additional money should be set aside from development projects as fee-in-lieu funds and designated for special facilities within the local area. This would help fund facilities that are usually constructed by public agencies. The facilities negotiated by the City are over and above those required by M-NCPPC.

Funds should be collected from several projects and added to public funds to finance these local special facilities. The primary use of fee-in-lieu funds should be for multi-purpose gymnasiums, and possibly, indoor swimming pools. Some fee-in-lieu money should also go to the construction of City-wide and regional biking/running trails.

10. OFF SITE FIELD CONSTRUCTION:

In light of the complexing policy outlined earlier and the needs assessment, consideration should be given to requiring developers to provide off-site field construction or fee-in-lieu funds, rather than solely on-site field construction for their projects.

11. USE AND ALLOCATION POLICY:

It is the policy of both the M-NCPPC and the City of Bowie that, generally, their parks and property remain open and available to the general public when not specifically permitted for organized activities. Board of Education properties typically are available after school, on weekends, and during other periods when school is not in session - again when not permitted for other usage. Organizations obtain specific use of properties through an allocation process where-in the City Parks and Recreation Office serves as a clearing house to review and process all requests for the use of properties within the City.

The allocation process was devised to allow City staff to assist the community by making more efficient use of all available properties. At the same time, it provided relief to both the M-NCPPC and the Board of Education by significantly reducing the interaction with the user groups. The process provides for the resolution of conflicts among user requests prior to the submission of those requests to the approving property owner, thus ensuring a more equitable distribution of the resources, i.e. multipurpose rooms and cafeterias.

It should be noted that while the system has worked extremely well, there are external influences which impact the process, reduce the availability of resources, and which effectively reduce the amount or quantity of resources, such as:

- M-NCPPC and Board of Education activities which pre-empt programmed indoor activities by user groups.
- Usage fees at Bowie State University and Sportfit which are prohibitive to many groups for programmed sports. Also, while figures for portions of the population which may be adjacent to but

outside city limits (e.g., Turf Farm) are not included in ratios developed for this report, that population can be expected to increase the demand and loading on resources within Bowie, thus effectively increasing shortfalls in various categories.

- Competing requirements for use of County (M-NCPPC) resources by adjacent communities such as Glenn Dale presently, and the Turf Farm potentially.

12. FUTURE TRENDS:

Recreational requirements often are impacted by developing interests which are the result of trends driven by athletic and recreational activity on a local, regional, and even global basis.

Locally, new opportunities for participation at the high school level and beyond may be created by changes in Board of Education athletic policy, which might add first - club level, then varsity/junior varsity level sports. Examples include girls' soccer and lacrosse.

The success of local university teams and teams at the national and international levels generates new or renewed interest in various programs. Such "spin-off" has included figure skating and gymnastics during the 1970's and 1980's; and soccer, women's softball, beach volleyball and swimming during the 1990's. Consistent quality performances in basketball, soccer, and field hockey by local universities keep the interests of youths elevated. Likewise, the success of teams at Bowie High School in baseball, soccer, and volleyball creates initiative for youngsters to participate in club programs.

Other individual sports, highly visible because of mass media exposure, also may generate a ground swell of enthusiasm and increased demand for opportunities to learn and participate - particularly among youth. Examples include Tiger Woods in golf and the Williams sisters in tennis.

Finally, a watchful eye must be given to the maturation of our community, where youth carry their love of sport into adulthood, and adults who phase through and then out of active programs into less stressful activities. A significant increase in the senior population of the City already has generated substantial interest which led to the Senior Center and Senior Softball League for this segment of the population. These things all must be monitored so that forecasts can be made, and resources and/or programming adjusted to ensure continuity in addressing and satisfying the recreational needs of the community.

13. FACILITY STANDARDS:

Population - to - facilities ratios in this document are compared to recommended standards used by the M-NCPPC, which in turn are derived from national guidelines for determining community standards of service developed by the NRPA, in conjunction with the American Academy for Park and Recreation Administration. Such guidelines are based on an analysis of a broad cross-section of communities across the country. The ratios contained herein have been provided as a comparative reference, and should not be interpreted to define rigid policy. They are intended only to help guide recommendations being made for the Bowie community.

The NRPA, in fact, qualifies its own standards and recommendations by stating that a community can, and should, select a facility menu which best satisfies the needs of its citizens, and that should be used by planners as guidelines and not axioms, i.e. Turf Farm.

Recent research by NRPA found considerable difference in facility development among award winning park and recreation departments from 1987 through 1992, when NRPA 1987 standards were in widespread use across the United States. A general consensus now is that facility standards are useful as guidelines, but that a community should determine what mix of facilities best meets its specific needs, and that strict adherence to standards is not realistic in the 2000's.

The ratio of existing facilities for the complete inventory of facilities within the city of Bowie was computed and is contained in Appendix A4. These ratios were derived by dividing the estimated populations of Table II by the quantities of facilities summarized in Appendix A3. Table III is a subset of the activities listed in Appendix A4, selected as the top 20 or so areas of interest for active recreation by Bowie citizens. The Bowie city-wide ratios are compared in this table with ratios developed for other Maryland localities with similar demographic characteristics (Annapolis, Columbia and Gaithersburg, and Laurel), and with the average ratio of those four comparable localities. This table is provided for information purposes only in making comparisons with the other cities, as data were not available for all activities in all the localities, and the use and management of resources was found to vary within and among the various locales.

This table compares the Bowie ratios for 2005 with the **averaged figures** for comparable cities contained in Table III, and where available, with standards used by the M-NCPPC. The M-NCPPC standards are derived from national guidelines for determining community standards of service as developed by the National Recreation and Parks Association and the American Academy for Park and Recreation Administration. The recommended quantities and ratios for 2005 are a subjective assessment by the Community Recreation Committee of what a reasonable proportion of resources to population ought to be, based on those comparisons, but adjusted or modified where experience with particular activities dictate. The recommended numbers are judgmental, but are based on current experience with the recreational environment of Bowie at the time of this study. Likewise, those numbers recommended for 2010 are a best estimate based on the current inventory of facilities, programmatic requirements of the user community, and the anticipated population growth. The **RATIOS FOR 2005** are derived by dividing the **2005 population (53795)** by the **QUANTITIES RECOMMENDED FOR 2005**; the **2010 QUANTITIES** are derived, for most activities, by dividing the **2010 population (63664)** by **RECOMMENDED RATIOS for 2010**. In some cases (e.g., Tennis and soccer), a specific increase in ratio was recommended. Recommended ratios, in most cases, have been rounded to the nearest whole number.

This information on this page is intended to provide a key for the rationale used in making the recommendations in Table IV for the quantity of facilities needed in 2005, and those projected to be needed by 2010. The recommendations are subjective, but are based on current experience with the recreational community in general, and from continuing interaction with user groups. The determination of CURRENT NEED, or ADEQUACY was based on that experience. Higher quantities were recommended where additional facilities were considered necessary to offset existing demand to allow for expansion by participating groups, to reduce loading, or to reduce field wear and tear, and thus enable improved use and control of properties in the inventory. Where the ADJUSTED RATIO for 2005 was considered adequate for the projected population, that ratio was used to generate the quantities needed for 2010. A **PROJECTED NEED** indicates where a specific increase in the number (Quantity) of facilities is recommended, based on current experience.

The Department of Parks and Recreation of the M-NCPPC has in its "Parks and Recreation Facilities Guidelines" a list of minimum facility requirements to be provided in developments. When a preliminary plat or a comprehensive design plan is submitted, a specific number of recreational facilities are expected to be provided based on the population that the project will generate. The developer dedicates land, provides private recreational facilities or pays a fee-in-lieu. Table XIII uses this list and the projected population growth in Table II to estimate the minimum number of facilities that can be expected as a result of this requirement. The table represents the minimum quantity of facilities recommended by the M-NCPPC to serve the projected increase in population (**highlighted above**), and is derived by dividing the projected increases in population for each area as shown in Table II by the recommended standards of the M-NCPPC as shown in this table (Table XIII = Table II (Population) divided by Table XIII (M-NCPPC Standards)).

Parking Standards: Recommended space requirements above do not include space for vehicular parking. NRPA general standards for parking recommend allowing 300 square feet minimum (400 square feet desirable) for each vehicle at a facility, based on parking stall sizes generally 6 to 8 feet wide by 18 to 22 feet long, with an additional 25 feet allowed for pulling out. At 400 square feet per car, one acre would be required for 109 cars. Additional space should be allowed to satisfy American with Disabilities Act requirements for accessible parking for individuals with physical disabilities.

The number of parking spaces required is a function of the type and size of facility and the specific activities. The following are recommended standards for three specific facilities. Parking standards for other types of recreational facilities are contained in the referenced NRPA publication.

- Neighborhood Park (15+ acres): A minimum of 5 spaces for the first two acres, and one space for each additional acre.
- Community park (25 + acres): A minimum of 5 spaces per acre, with additional spaces for major facilities.
- Athletic field (separate or combined): 5-8 spaces per acre depending upon spectator seating accommodation of 3.5 passengers per car.
- Recreation complex (with or without a park or sports field): Parking should be calculated on a minimum of one car space for every four patrons. This is an additional to the parking requirements for the park or sports field.

NOTE: The Community Recreation Committee has found through its experience that the ratio of participant to driver is less than NRPA standards for athletic fields. Parking requirements appear to be more a function of the number of participants in the activity than spectator seating or vehicular loading. The CRC recommends providing one parking space for each 1.5 to 2 participants, where the maximum number is required for facilities where games/activities are conducted back-to-back.
