SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On March 23, 2012 At approximately 0702 hours, Bowie Police responded to 16200 block of Pennsbury Drive for the report of a home invasion. Upon arrival, the victims stated that at approximately 0500 hours, two suspects armed with semi-auto style handguns, entered their residence through an unsecured window. The suspects proceeded to tie up three of the occupants and searched the house for valuables. After approximately two hours, the suspects left the residence in one of the victim's vehicle. Various items of value were taken from the residence as well. The victim's vehicle was later recovered in the District of Columbia. Prince George's County Robbery is leading the investigation.
