City of Bowie Election Day Information

The City of Bowie will hold an election on Tuesday, November 3, 2015. All city offices including Mayor, At-Large Councilmembers, and District Councilmembers are up for election. Election information, including a sample ballot and polling places, can be found at www.cityofbowie.org/election.

In 2013 voters supported an advisory ballot question to change the terms of office from two to four years. Those elected in November 2015 will be the first to serve four year terms of office.

Other information about the Bowie City election:

- Voters can cast four votes: one for Mayor, one for their District Councilmember, and up to two At-Large Councilmembers.
- Polls are open on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- City elections are non partisan.
- There will be no voting updates provided during the day.
- Election results will be issued as soon as possible after polls close.
