INCIDENT: Residential Breaking and Entering

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On 03/28/2016 at 0800 hours, Officers responded to a residence on the 3000 block of Stonybrook Drive for a burglary. Upon arrival, Officers spoke to the victim who stated the incident occurred on 03/27/16. The rear door was forced open as a means of entry. Once inside, the suspect stole jewelry and credit cards that belonged to the victim. On 03/27/16, the defendant Alford used the credit card at the Shell Station on Superior Lane. Surveillance video was obtained and a wanted poster was issued. Several Officers were able to identify Alford, Roderick as the suspect. Based upon this information, Investigators obtained an arrest warrant for the defendant.

On 04/21/16, Detectives canvassed the area of Hilltop Shopping Center and apprehended the defendant. During the interrogation, the defendant confessed to the additional residential burglaries listed below and will be charged accordingly:
