Bowie Senior Center Closed for Major Air Conditioning Repairs

Beginning Saturday, June 4, the Bowie Senior Center will be closed for an indefinite period of time for major work on the building's air conditioning system. This is a necessary step, but not one taken lightly, as we know it will be an inconvenience to the many seniors who regularly visit the Senior Center and participate in its programs. The Center will reopen just as soon as the work is completed, but there is no estimated date for the reopening at this point.

As many senior services as possible are being moved to the Kenhill Center. Fitness room users will be welcomed in the exercise rooms at all three M-NCPPC Community Centers located in the City. The transportation program will continue unchanged. All scheduled cultural and recreational trips will continue, as will many clubs, seminars, support groups, and classes. On Wednesday, June 8 we will also be launching an exciting new summer program entitled *Express Learning* which will consist of 35 one-hour seminars on a variety of topics. Senior Center patrons are invited to come to the Kenhill Center and join in the fun.
