**INCIDENT: First Degree Assault**

On 9/2/16 at 1045 hrs, Bowie Police responded to the 16400 Block of Banbury Drive in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, Officers made attempts to contact the complainant, but the residence appeared empty. Officers received an additional call in the 16300 Block of Banbury Drive, in which a female advised that her husband (Victim 2) had been punched by an unknown male. Investigation revealed that the female (Victim 1) involved in the original domestic call, flagged down Victim 2, who was driving and told him that her ex-boyfriend was chasing her and was going to kill her. Victim 2 then let Victim 1 get into his vehicle. The Suspect then used his vehicle, a 2007 Chevrolet Monte Carlo, to intentionally strike the rear of the Victim 2's vehicle several times, causing Victim 2 to lose consciousness. The Suspect exited his vehicle, opened the door of the Victim 2's vehicle, and struck him several times in the face with an unknown object.

Victim 1 fled the scene on foot. Investigation showed Victim 1 was involved in an argument with the Suspect, who dragged her down the stairs of her residence and chased her down the street.

As a result of the assault, Victim 2 sustained a fractured jaw and other serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital. Victim 1 refused medical attention. A warrant for Attempted First Degree Murder was issued for the Suspect, ROBERT WALDORF MALLETTTE.
