B. Navy Federal Credit Union

The applicant is requesting the City's recommendation of approval for the construction of a one-story/4,175 sq. ft. credit union facility with 36 on-site parking spaces and three drive-thru lanes on a 2.23 acre site. The property is a vacant lot, located immediately south of the existing On the Border restaurant, in the northwestern quadrant of the U.S. Route 301/MD Route 197 intersection, and is zoned C-M (Commercial Miscellaneous), where the use is permitted by right under the Prince George's County Zoning Ordinance – **Public Hearing/Eligible for Action**
