On January 10, 2017 at approximately 1244 hours, Bowie Police units were dispatched to the 12700 Block of Midwood Lane in reference to a reported citizen robbery. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the victim, who advised that at approximately 1230, hours he arrived home from work, and while walking to his front door, two unknown males approached him and asked the victim what he had in his pockets. The victim stated that one of the males grabbed him while the other punched him in the face and took the victim's phone. The victim advised that the suspects were wearing dark clothes and black masks covering their faces. A perimeter was established and PGPD K-9 responded to the scene, but was unable to conduct a track of the suspects. The victim sustained a laceration to his chin area and was transported to Prince George's Hospital Center by Prince George's County EMS. CBPD Detectives responded to the scene to speak with the victim and take over the investigation.
