REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY, APRIL 17, 2017

CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the Bowie City Council was held on Monday, April 17, 2017 in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m.


