Status Report

1. WSSC Sanitary Sewer Repairs

WSSC has notified Public Works of an emergency repair to a large sanitary sewer located near the Long Ridge neighborhood. A temporary sewer has been installed and can be seen just west of the neighborhood. Repair of the sewer will require trenching in Linden Lane. WSSC expects to carry out this work January through March of 2018. They will inform residents that are impacted by the work residents, and will coordinate final street repairs with City Public Works staff. The attached letter includes a map showing the repair location.

2. Senior Center Chair Replacement

The Adopted FY18 Budget has allocated \$36,000 for the replacement of 120 chairs for the Senior Center dining room. Staff has located a Mid-Atlantic Purchasing Team Contract (#2015-42) with Douron Inc. through which we can purchase 120 Bola Fixed Back, Upholstered Standard Arm Chairs for a total delivered cost of \$35,999.25.

As provided by Section 62 of the City Charter, this will serve as the required seven (7) day notice of intent to issue a purchase order to Douron Inc. in that amount.

This letter is to advise the City of Bowie of emergency work that needs to be performed. The Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) has investigated and found the sewer segment located at the location listed below has deteriorated to the point that total pipe failure is imminent.

Please find attached a map for the emergency work area listed above.
