### *Status Report*

1. Stream and Community Cleanups

On Saturday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, 51 residents including staff from MOM's Organic Market plus members of the Church of Christ turned out to help clean streams and roads around Bowie. A total of 425 pounds of trash and 375 pounds of recycling were collected and bagged from five different sites. An additional 100 or so pounds of bulk items were found, including one shopping cart, one suitcase, several containers of used oil, and a kid's bike. A special thanks also goes out to residents in Bowie Station and Covington Condos for working in their neighborhoods as part of Bowie's first Stream and Community Cleanup day.

Also, on Monday, April 9, a group of 18 Bowie State University faculty, staff, students (including members of the football team), and Dr. Aminta Breaux participated in Community Day, one of several special events preceding the official installation of Dr. Breaux as president. For part of the day, they volunteered to clean a forested parcel between City Hall and the shoppes at Bowie Town Center. They collected two tires and bagged up approximately 80 pounds of trash and 100 pounds of recycling.
