### *Status Report*

1. Trails Master Plan Workshop - May 4

This Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, the City will host the second public workshop regarding the update to the Trails Master Plan. The workshop will be held from 9:00 a.m. to Noon at The Kenhill Center. The format of the workshop will be an Open House, with a brief presentation at 9:00 a.m. Participants will have an opportunity to review display boards showing several alternatives developed after Workshop #1, which was held in February, and provide additional comments. All are welcome and encouraged to attend.

2. Upcoming Development Meetings - Melford Apartment Site Plans

The City has scheduled several public meetings for the next phases of multi-family apartment development at Melford Village. Two site plans are proposed: one for up to 436 multi-family apartments in nine buildings (in a project called Melford Mansions) and one for infrastructure related to a 472-unit building (similar to the previously reviewed Aspen product). A Stakeholders Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. and Bowie Advisory Planning Board public hearings are scheduled for Tuesday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. Both meetings will be held in the Council Chambers. These same applications are scheduled for City Council public hearings on July 1<sup>st</sup>. For more information, please contact the Planning Department.
