### *Status Report*

1. Vehicle Replacements

The FY20 Budget allocates for the purchase of replacement vehicles and equipment. The Department of Community Services has identified contracts available for piggyback to make the purchases. All items are within their budgeted amounts. The purchases are:

As provided by Section 62 of the City Charter, this will serve as the required seven-day notice of intent to issue purchase orders to Hertrich Fleet Services, Inc., Criswell Fleet Sales, and Lindsay Ford of Wheaton for the amounts listed above.

2. County Committee Results (CB-13-2019)

Today, the Prince George's County Council's Planning, Housing and Economic Development (PHED) Committee reviewed CB-13-2019, a zoning text amendment sponsored by Council Chair Todd Turner that will allow eating and drinking establishments, with drive-through service, in the C-O (Commercial Office ) Zone. City Council chose to support this legislation earlier this week, voting unanimously in favor of the bill, which will allow the existing Dunkin Donuts business in Bowie Plaza to move across the street into the vacant bank building at the corner of MD 197 and Old Chapel Road. Council Member Derrick Davis moved a FAVORABLE recommendation for CB-13; his motion was seconded by Chair Dannielle Glaros. The motion passed 3-0-1 (with Council Member Tom Dernoga abstaining and Committee Vice-Chair Calvin Hawkins absent). A public hearing will be scheduled in about a month. If approved, the bill becomes effective 45 days after enactment.

3. City Elections

Resident Len Lucchi filed his candidacy paperwork on May 21 for the Mayor seat and Councilmember Dufour Woolfley filed on June 3 for District 2 Council seat.
