SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On September 11, 2012 at 2218 hours, Bowie Officers responded to 16503 Governor Bridge Road for a report of a hit and run. Once on scene, officers observed a gray 2008 Toyota Camry with heavy front and rear passenger side damage parked in the parking lot. The suspect was observed walking near the vehicle. A witness on scene stated that they observed the suspect drive the vehicle into the parking lot and park it prior to police arrival. Further investigation revealed that the vehicle had struck a tree in the 17000 block of Governor Bridge Road. After speaking with the suspect, officers detected the smell of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. The suspect was put through the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests with unsatisfactory results. He was determined to have been under the influence while operating a motor vehicle and placed under arrest. The suspect was then transported to Greenbelt Police Department for a breath test where he registered a BAC of .14 and was issued multiple traffic citations. There were no injuries.
