SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On October 11, 2012 at approximately 1100 hours, Bowie Police responded to 12418 Sandal Lane for an unconscious male that was not breathing. The deceased was visiting acquaintances at the aforementioned address and had allegedly been drinking the night before and using heroine. He was found this morning by the occupants of the house. He was transported to the Bowie Health Center and efforts to resuscitate him continued there. He was eventually pronounced dead at 1128 hours. Examination of the body revealed that the deceased had signs of intravenous drug usage on his arms and also had multiple bruises on his face.

The medical examiner responded to the Bowie Health Center to take custody of the body. Prince George's County Police Homicide responded as well to assume the investigation. All of the occupants of the house were transported to Prince George's County Police District III Headquarters to be interviewed.
