Excerpt from an update issued by the Governor's office today:

“While yesterday the United States saw a record number of COVID-19 cases, in Maryland, our key health metrics continue to trend in a positive direction. Our daily positivity rate reached a new low of 4.38%, and our seven-day positivity rate fell to 5.05%. Our total current hospitalizations have dropped to 511, their lowest level in 83 days. We have now conducted more than 600,000 tests and have nearly 200 testing sites available across the state.

As we continue to safely reopen, **it is important to remember that this crisis is still not behind us.** Now more than ever, as we begin to come into contact with more people, we must all continue to remain vigilant. Our health and economic recovery depend on all of us continuing to exercise personal responsibility in order to keep ourselves, our family members, our neighbors, and our coworkers safe. **We encourage all Marylanders to get tested, wear a mask, and practice physical distancing.**”
