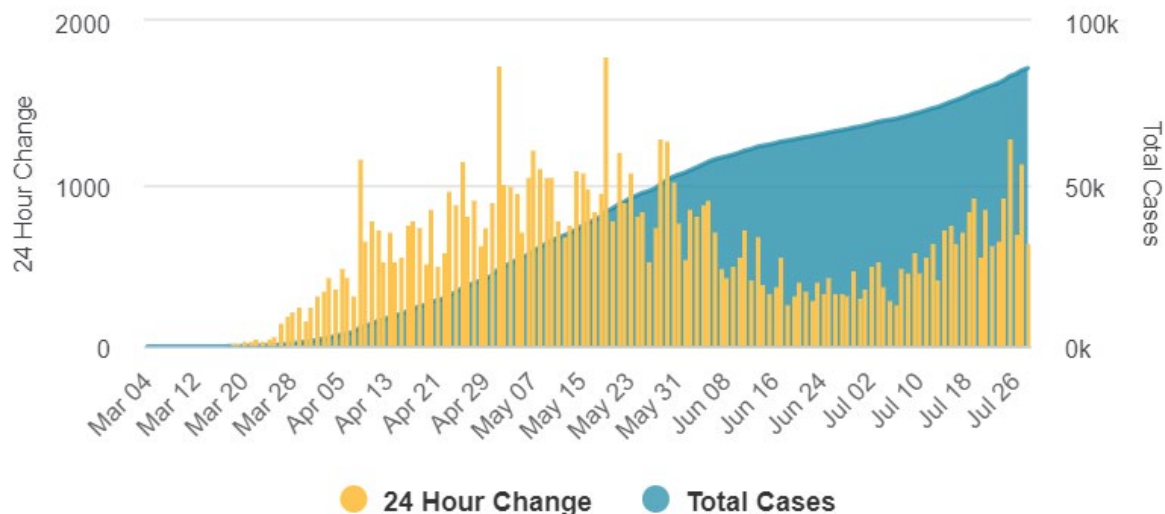

Maryland Update

Health officials around the state are monitoring the daily figures closely. The number of new cases is trending higher in the Baltimore region, although all regions are reporting some increases in case numbers. Yesterday on CNN, Governor Hogan said the state's reopening plan is in a "holding pattern" and that the state is not ready to reopen anything further.

Maryland is averaging about 20,000 tests per day. Delays in test results seem to be improving a little, but state officials strongly advise Marylanders concerned about delays in testing turnaround time to use state-operated testing sites, where the turnaround time is generally as low as 24 - 48 hours.
