

Tropical Storm Update

Tropical Storm Isaias paid a brief visit to Bowie this morning. Fortunately, because the storm did not linger, the impacts were not great as they could have been. Approximately four inches of rain fell here, which caused some minor street flooding. There have been scattered power outages and a very few downed trees, but for the most part, Bowie came through the storm very well.

Public Works collections were suspended today because of the storm. They will return to normal tomorrow with Special Pickups, and Yard Waste and Recycling collection.

Bowie Update

In light of Governor Hogan's expanded orders regarding face coverings and social distancing, face coverings that cover the nose and mouth will now be required for anyone who enters the City Gymnasium, including those who are using the courts. This is a change in policy as masks were not previously required while practicing on the courts or walking around the perimeter of the Gymnasium. The mask requirement will also apply to all who enter the Ice Arena when it reopens for public skating sessions.

Furthermore, due to the risk of community spread, the City of Bowie has decided to cancel all public events through October.
